



# Birthday Stars

## \*Star Gazers\*

### Directions:

Birthday Stars are a great way to celebrate Birthdays and/or Star of the Week, and get to know your students!

1. Make a tracer of a star shape.
2. Instruct students that the purpose of the star is that on a particular birthday (or when they are Star of the Week, the star will be mounted in celebration of that occasion.
3. Students should trace one star shape each.
4. Cut out the star.
5. Students print/write their names prominently in the center of the star.
6. Birthdates should be written underneath their names.
7. Each point of the star should have significant information, both written and illustrated.
  - \*My Family Members (includes pets)
  - \*My Goals, Hopes, Dreams
  - \*Favorite Hobbies (includes sports)
  - \*Best Friends
  - \*Favorite School Subjects or Special Occasions
8. Decorate the star with markers, pencil crayons, sparkles
9. If you are looking for a bulletin board caption, try \*Star Gazers\*!
