SUBJECT: Family Life and Take Charge Programs

GRADE: 2

### FAMILY LIFE PROGRAM:

The Family Life program aims to support parents in fostering in their children the development of positive attitudes towards interpersonal and social relationships, a strong self-esteem and moral development within the context of the Catholic faith and the Christian family.

The units are integrated with other subject areas such as Religion, Language Arts and Environmental Studies where appropriate.

### TAKE CHARGE PROGRAM:

The Child and Family Services Act addresses the issue of neglect and abuse of children with objectives for teachers at various levels. The following are the objectives for Grade Two.

#### Part 1

##### *Objectives:*

Students will develop the understanding that each person owns and is responsible for his/her own body and feelings.

##### *Concepts:*

Everyone has feelings.

Everyone has a body.

Some parts of your body are private.

Your body and your feelings belong to you.

#### Part 2

##### *Objectives:*

Students will gain a better understanding of how sexual abuse occurs; who the offender may be; how to recognize potentially dangerous situations; and what to do to prevent sexual abuse.

*Concepts:*

Different kinds of touching give you different feelings.

Some touching may confuse you and be wrong.

Someone may try to talk you into touching that is wrong.

Someone may tell you to keep a secret about touching.

Part 3

*Objectives:*

Students will develop assertive behaviour through opportunities to participate in role-playing and discussion using "what if" cards. Students will also develop an understanding of the importance of reporting and will identify adults to whom they can turn to for help.

*Concepts:*

Trust your feelings.

You can say "no".

You can talk to someone about touching that is wrong.

There are people who can help you.

Evaluation Procedures

1. Observation of student by teacher;
2. Student participation;
3. Student behaviour in other situations.
